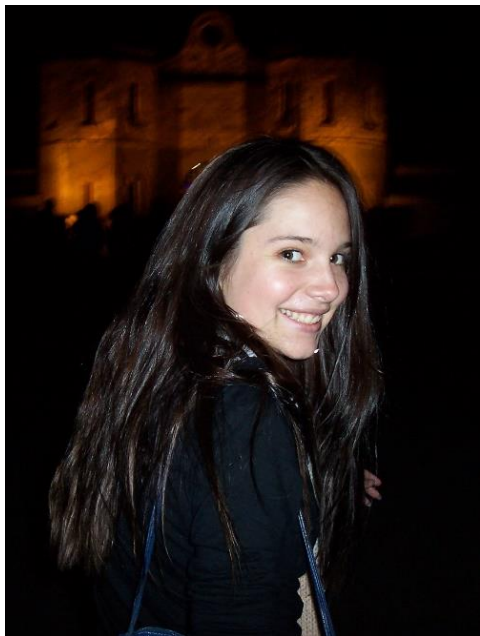


Alysha (Lee)
